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**RESULTS OF THE TRANSVERSAL ANALYSIS**

Once completed the transversal analysis of the data and information collected via the tools and the visit reports during the first half of the project, the COMMIT partners validated the draft reports during their latest partners' meeting, held in Brussels on 18-19 November 2015. The results of this process is a comprehensive Technical Report containing information on the theoretical settings, the methodology and the findings obtained out of the data collection and the analysis carried out.

A major outcome of the analysis work is a set of 12 Policy Reminders, addressed to European, national and regional stakeholders and aimed to remind them about the importance of fostering higher education institutions' commitment to lifelong learning and the social dimension. The final products of COMMIT include also an Executive Summary which

summarises the main results of the project and the research carried out during the last two years.

In addition to the outcomes mentioned above, the COMMIT transversal analysis also contributed to the drafting of a social dimension matrix, which summarises the main understanding of the university social dimension aspects, according to the COMMIT partner universities and the COMMIT work. A list of real examples and practical cases of implementation of the social

dimension is also provided, to help the reader fully grasp the concrete meaning of this dimension.

As for the new tool developed by COMMIT – the *Tool for monitoring attainment*, a feasibility study on its use at national and European level is being finalised. A revised, more user-friendly version of the Tool will be produced by the end of the project.

All the COMMIT products will be soon made available and downloadable in an electronic format, along with the COMMIT Tools. The Executive Summary and the Policy Reminders will also be available in hard-copy. We invite you to keep following the project news to know when the products become available!
